Vendor Rules and Information

1. Red Power Round UP name or logo, clothes/items cannot be sold without the approval of Nebraska Chapter 12.
2. All vendors will be notified where to receive your passes by email.
3. Set-up time begins on Tuesday, June 13th at 8:00 AM and must be off the premises by noon on Sunday June 18th.
4. No gas-powered vehicles will be allowed in the inside vendor buildings. Garage door access for hand carts or battery vehicles will be available Tuesday & Wednesday for stocking and setup and again Saturday evening from 5:00 PM – 7:00 PM and Sunday 8:00 AM until Noon.
5. Building times: 8 am to 5 PM daily. Doors will be open for restocking at 7 AM and all vendors are to be at their spaces by 8 AM.
6. All vendors must stay in assigned areas.
7. At the start of the show, all aisles must be clear and for safety reasons, nothing is to be in front of tables or on the floor in front of tables. Do not block openings between vendor spaces.
8. All vendors must provide their own electric cords, tape to cover cord, and table covers.
9. Not posting signs, banners or advertising outside your own area.
10. No pets are allowed.
11. The use, possession, or consumption of alcoholic beverages are not permitted on show grounds
12. Vendor is responsible for all Nebraska Sales Taxes
13. After unload, all vehicles must be moved to parking area.
14. Lost, stolen and/or damaged items are NOT the responsibility of Chapter 12 or guests. Vendors and helpers accept full responsibility for any injury or loss to themselves or their property while attending the show.
15. **Insurance:** Vendor agrees to secure, at its own expense, a general liability insurance policy, with an insurance company authorized to do business in Nebraska. Such policy shall name (A) International Harvester Collectors, Inc., (B) Big Red Collectors, Inc. (Chapter 12), (C) Hall County Livestock Improvement Association, d/b/a Fonner Park, (D) Fonner Exposition and Event Center, Inc., d/b/a Heartland Event Center, (E) The Nebraska State Fair, and (F) The City of Grand Island as additional insured parties against all claims for injury or death to persons and injury to or destruction of property and may not exclude products-completed operations hazard coverage. The minimum limits of said insurance policy shall be one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for bodily injury, property damage, personal and advertising injury and products/completed operations hazard per occurrence, and two million dollars (\$2,000,000) in the aggregate for all coverages, the terms of such coverage to coincide with the term of the show days. At least ten (10) days prior to commencement of the term of this Agreement, Vendor shall either furnish Rainprotection.net with a Certificate of Insurance signed by an agent authorized to sign for the issuing company or arrange to purchase the required insurance through the Rainprotection web page link on the Nebraska Chapter 12 website. If said Certificate is not provided, Vendor shall not be allowed to participate in event.
